

WORKSHOP INSTRUCTIONS

Start

With smooth cotton yarn and size 3 needle cast on provisionally 140 stitches.

If you aren't confident about casting on provisionally just cast on as usual and knit one round.

Place marker and join, being careful not to twist the stitches on the needle.

Cap Body

Rounds 1–56: Work Chart A: Cap Body, repeating the chart 7 times.

Notes: On Round 33 mark 7 decrease points in preparation for the decreases that begin on Round 34—these decrease points are shown by the single-stitch column in the center of the chart.

Switch to double-pointed needles when necessary.

Stitch count: 14.

Round 57: With _____ **, [CDD, k1] 3 times; k2tog.

Stitch count: 7.

Break the yarn, leaving a 6" tail. Thread onto tapestry needle, run the needle through the live stitches and pull the hole closed.

Ribbing

Unpick provisional cast on and place the stitches on the size 1 needle. Place marker and with _____ ** [k8, k2tog] 14 times.

Stitch count: 126.

Work [k1, p1] rib for 1".

Cast off in rib.

Darn in all ends. Block by soaking in warm water for at least 20 minutes. Squeeze out water (but do not twist cap), lay flat on a towel, pat into shape, and let dry.
